



Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Acharya Institutes, Bengaluru, India

And

Universitas Nasional, Jakarta, Indonesia

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is entered into by and between Acharya Institutes (hereinafter referred to as "AI"), located in Bengaluru, India, and Universitas Nasional (hereinafter referred to as "UNAS"), located in Jakarta, Indonesia.

All and UNAS agree to explore the possibility of developing the highest quality programs to advance the needs to All and UNAS. All and UNAS are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties."

It is hereby specifically agreed to between the Parties that this MoU is a broad based general agreement. Later the Parties would sit down and bring out another agreement which would deal with specific areas of mutual cooperation as also the commercials pertaining to the same. The Annexure so prepared at a later date would form part and parcel of this agreement. This MoU serves as an institutional framework for collaborative activities. Specific agreements would need to be drafted by the Parties in the case that the exploration of these areas leads to further developments. These agreements would need to be approved by authorities at each institution. Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the parties.

Background

Acharya Institutes

Collaboration

The Parties aspire to sign an MoU as a way to develop a collaborative relationship in the following broad areas:

Student Internships

The Parties will provide internships to students every year in pre-specified areas. The Parties will identify the students from the respective domain areas who can work with professors from AI or UNAS to undertake projects in AI or UNAS. The students will then travel to India or Indonesia during the specified period for a 3-6-month internship.

Joint Programs

The Parties will offer various certificate courses and also joint research programs. The courses and topics, the pre-requisites, the qualifications and the level of the students to be trained will

depend on the areas specified. Based on specific requirements, AI or UNAS will work out the contents, delivery modality, commercials, etc. Any joint program will be determined in details in specific agreements to be approved by the authorities of each institution.

Student and Faculty Exchange Program

The Parties will encourage contact and cooperation among their members and department units. Both will depute their experienced faculty for training assignments that would be carried out by AI or UNAS. Both Parties agree to actively seek sponsorship from various local, national and international funding sources in support of such collaborative educational activities.

The Parties understand that financial arrangements under this MoU would have to be negotiated and would depend on specific activities and the availability of funds. Any expense by either party would be subject to individual agreements on a case-by-case basis. The parties also recognize that intellectual property terms would need to be included in subsequent agreements, as appropriate. In addition, anyone from AI or UNAS teaching at the Parties's institutions must have the approved credentials.

The term of this MoU is five (5) years commencing on the Effective Date. The Parties will review this MoU one-and-a-half (1 ½) years after the Effective Date to assess results. This MoU is non-exclusive. The MoU could be renewed upon the mutual consent of the Parties.

This MoU may be amended or further developed by means of written consent on the part of the Signatories or their designated representatives. The MoU may be terminated with at least 90 days' advance written notice. Notices must be sent to the individuals and addresses indicated below:

The Parties stipulate that the use of their respective brands, represented by their headings and logo types, could only be used by a Party with the previous and express authorization of the other Party.

This MoU does not authorize any one of the Parties and represent and warrant that they have the requisite authority to bind their respective institutions.

This MoU shall be prepared in English and Indonesian language, for two (2) copies of equal validity and in the event of conflict or misinterpretation, the English version shall prevail. One (1) copy will remain in the possession of each of the Parties.
